



2019 ARTS INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

What:

400 hours of paid work experience for eligible undergraduate college students over the summer. Students are paid \$14.25 an hour to work in nonprofit literary, performing and presenting arts organizations and municipal arts agencies throughout Los Angeles County. Interns also participate in additional educational components (called "Peer Groups") provided by the Arts Commission.

Who:

To be eligible to participate, students must:

- Be currently enrolled in a community college, four-year college or university program. (Recent graduates may apply as long as they have completed their degree between May 1 - September 1, 2019.)
- **Either reside in Los Angeles County or attend school in Los Angeles County.**

* Proof of residency and enrollment are required to verify eligibility. Students who have previously participated in the Los Angeles County Arts Internship Program are not eligible to participate a second time.

All college students regardless of race, religion, sex, national origin, age, sexual orientation, or disability who meet the above criteria are eligible to apply to participate in the Los Angeles County Arts Internship Program.

Candidates can be sought from all areas of undergraduate study and are not required to have demonstrated a previous commitment to the arts.

When:

This internship program takes place between June and August 2019.

How:

Students apply directly to the arts organization providing the internship by submitting a cover letter and resume. Available internships will be listed no later than March 30, 2019 on the Los Angeles County Arts Commission web site at <https://www.lacountyarts.org/opportunities/arts-internship-program-students/about-arts-internship-program-students>. Interested students should apply as soon as positions are posted as there is stiff competition for a limited number of internships.
